Parents, what you need to know BEFORE your children return to school in Sept. 2017

What **YOU** need to know before children return to school.

There is—mandated in all schools by the BC Ministry of Education—a "sex positive" movement that parents have not been informed about. Most parents are horrified when they find out what is transpiring under the Trojan horse false flag of "anti-bullying" and "diversity".

"Sex at Lunch" is one such program, held at Lord Byng secondary school in Vancouver. This did not appear on the school calendar, and participating students—about 250—were directed not to record, take pictures or post any information about it on social media. Grade 10-12 student participants study "porn" and the "History of Masturbation"—and ended the 2017 school year with a game show that pitted four students against four teachers. The moderator, a woman wearing tight jeans and red stiletto high heels, welcomed the kids by calling them "sex addicts."

Some examples of the 48 questions in this 'quiz': "If you don't want to masturbate, what do you eat for breakfast?"; "People who enjoy putting on fuzzy animal costumes for sexual purposes are called [what]?"; "What is the song by Cindy Lauper that's about masturbation?"; "At what age can you legally text somebody a picture of your naked bits?"; "What does one use to perform safer oral sex on a woman?"; and "Which country has a penis and vagina festival?" and more.

"Out in Schools" facilitators visit schools around the province without parental consent or notification. One of the presenters uses the nom de plume "jenderfuck." This program is financed by the Queer Film Festival's parent organization "Out on Screen".

Students are being subjected to psychological conditioning that breaks down common-sense thinking & logic, undermines parental authority, and promotes discrimination against anyone who doesn't "affirm" the sex activists' agenda.

Students are encouraged to make 'social justice videos, and 'winners' get to attend a party in conjunction with the Queer Film Festival—a party that exposes them to hard-core homosexual pornography and propaganda films, like this year's choice about a young girl who develops a crush on her female teacher.

"SOGI" (Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity) is the rebranded term for LGBTQ2+++, and it's the most pervasive attempt yet to poison the minds of children with sex activist propaganda, and thus attack Canadian culture.
