

Why PUC?

All across Canada, parental rights are being systematically attacked. Special-interest groups have made our schools a political battleground.

The health-care system has usurped the rights of parents to be informed decision-makers. Fiscal lunacy fails to protect future generations from economic and taxation disasters.

This role translates into a protected sphere of parental decision-making which is rooted in the presumption that parents should make important decisions affecting their children, both because parents are more likely to appreciate the best interests of their children, and because the state is illequipped to make such decisions itself."

"The common law has long recognized that parents are in the best position to take care of their children and make all the decisions necessary to ensure their well-being."
